



**Hardin County Republican Party of Kentucky
GOP Meeting Minutes
Monday October 13, 2025**

- **Call to Order:** The regular meeting of the Hardin County GOP was held Monday October 13, 2025, at ECTC RPC - 212. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Chairman Bobbie Coleman
- **The Invocation** was delivered by Timothy Walls, followed by The Pledge of Allegiance and National Anthem led by Mary Johnson.
- Willie Oden made a motion for Patti Hester to be the Pro-tem Secretary due to Wanda Orr being absent from the meeting. The motion was seconded and passed by unanimous voice vote
- **Roll Call for Quorum:** Pro-tem Secretary Patti Hester, called Roll Call and established a quorum.
- **Approval of Minutes:** Rob Reynolds made a motion to accept the September 8, 2025, regular meeting minutes and the October 3, 2025, Special Meeting minutes as written. The motion was seconded and passed by unanimous voice vote
